Art Guidelines

In order to submit art to the contest, please make sure to include the following on the back of the submission:

- **The name of the student,**
- **Grade level of the student,**
- **The teacher's name and email**
- **Home address of the student, and**
- **Parent contact information (phone and email - if the parents have email).**

The deadline to submit the students' art is **Monday, April 3rd by 4pm**. Please leave the art submissions in the front office and we will pick them up directly from your school.

For the 2024 Linda Vista Multi-Cultural Fair the theme is "The View From Home" and we are celebrating the beautiful view Linda Vista has evolved to.

The Art Prompt is:

Imagine you are an explorer in Linda Vista! Take a stroll around your house and look out the windows. What do you see? What places or things make your neighborhood special to you? Think about the colors, sounds, and feelings that come to mind when you look at your surroundings.

Now, pretend you are an artist, and it's time to share your adventure with others. Create an art piece about "The View From Home." Describe the scenes outside your window and the places that make your neighborhood unique. How does the view from your home make you feel? Share your favorite things about your neighborhood and why it is so special to you.

The art can be either portrait or landscape and any medium the student chooses, the size is regular printing paper – 8.5 x 11.

Students who participate in the Art contest must be in 2nd 3rd 4th or 5th grade. The Art will be judged by Members of the Linda Vista Multicultural Fair Board.

Every student who enters the contest is invited to be a part of the parade. Trophies must be displayed at the student's school.
