In order to submit essays to the contest, please make sure to include the following on the back of the submission:

- **The name of the student,**
- **Grade level of the student,**
- **The teacher's name and email**
- **Home address of the student, and**
- **Parent contact information (phone and email – if the parents have email).**

The deadline to submit the student essays is **Tuesday, April 2nd by 4pm**. Please either leave essay submissions at the front office and we will pick it directly from your school, or bring submissions to the front circulation desk at the Linda Vista Library.

For the 2019 Linda Vista Multi-Cultural Fair the theme is “Celebrating Our Youth” and we are celebrating our youth of all ages in Linda Vista. We know our youth impact and shape Linda Vista in a variety of ways and do great things in the community.
