In order to submit an essay or poem to the contest, please make sure to include the following:

- Name
- Grade level
- The teacher's name and email
- Home address of the student
- Parent contact information (phone and email if the parents have email).

The deadline to submit the student essay is **Friday, March 28 by 12pm**. Please email a clear picture or PDF file of your submission to <u>lvfaircontest@gmail.com</u> with the student's information.

The Essay & Poetry Prompt is:

Use these questions as inspiration for your essay:

- What is your favorite restaurant in Linda Vista, and why?
- Do you have a favorite homemade meal that brings back special memories?
- How does food help you feel connected to your culture, family, or the Linda Vista community?

Participants must be in 5th, 6th, 7th, or 8th grade. The Essay will be judged by Members of the Linda Vista Multi-Cultural Fair Board.

Every student who enters the contest is invited to participate in the parade. Trophies must be displayed at the student's school.
